




What EDA's Mission Means to You

★ Sharing of information between partners and stakeholders


★ Demonstrate consistency between CEDS and projects



★ High Unemployment

★ 24-month unemployment rate for the region must be greater than 1% of the National Average


★ Low Per Capita Income
★ The PCI for the region must be less than 80% of the National Average.







★ Special Need
★ Sudden and severe
unemployment event
★ Natural disaster
★ Biomass closure communities
★ Coal-impacted communities

As defined by EDA, "special need" includes meeting one or more of the following criteria:

- i) Closure or restructuring of industries or the loss of a major employer essential to the regional economy as defined by:
 - a) a public announcement of an impending closure or restructuring of a firm expected to occur within four (4) years of review of an application submission; or
 - b) an actual closure or restructuring of a firm within the 24 months prior to submission of an application, resulting in sudden job losses; AND
 - such threatened or actual closure results in sudden job losses meeting the following dislocation criteria:
 - For regions with a population of at least 100,000, the threatened or actual dislocation is 500 jobs, or one percent of the civilian labor force (CLF), whichever is less.
 - For regions with a population up to 100,000, the threatened or actual dislocation is 200 jobs, or one percent of the CLF, whichever is less.



- Natural or other major disasters or emergencies. A region that has received one of the following disaster declarations is eligible:
 - a) A Presidentially declared disaster (declared under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. § 5121 et seq.)); or
 - b) A Federally declared disaster (pursuant to the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act, as amended (16 U.S.C. § 1861a(a)); the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, as amended (7 U.S.C. § 1961); or the Small Business Act, as amended (Pub. L. No. 85- 536, 15 U.S.C. § 631 et seq., 72 Stat. 384 (1958)).
